We have two routes that you could choose for your training, salaried or tuition fee. Please see the table below for further information.

Salaried Route	Tuition Fee Route
2.5 years prior work experience is desirable - this may or may not be school based	No prior work experience required, although some experience in a school is highly desired
Two weeks of in-school experience	
Receive a competitive salary which varies according to prior experience and where you are employed	Trainees pay fees of around £9,250 - subject to change
Awarded QTS (with an option of converting to PGCE during the year at a cost to the trainee)	Awarded QTS and a PGCE

As we are looking for candidates from a strong academic background we require a minimum qualification of an undergraduate degree at 2:2 level and GCSEs in Maths, English and Science of grade C or 4 and above.
