



# NQT Primary Partnership Programme

**Innovative programme for NQTs in Newham and beyond.**

This programme will support NQTs to enhance their classroom practice and to meet the Teachers' Standards.

This evidence informed programme is co-designed and co-facilitated by UCL Institute of Education and Teaching Schools within Newham to enable NQTs to show impact in their classroom and improve outcomes for pupils.



## Programme Details

### Who can apply?

This programme is for NQTs in Newham and schools within their Teaching School Alliances.

### Programme Structure

This programme is informed by national and international research. NQTs will engage in a blend of interactive sessions - including the opportunity to visit classrooms - reading, reflection and action research.

The core programme consists of five modules studied over a four week cycle. NQTs will have an opportunity to visit host schools, carry out learning walks and learn from experienced practitioners. Intersessional tasks will be undertaken between sessions.

## Core Programme

### Introductory Session

Making the most of your NQT year

### Module 1: Behaviour to maximise learning

This module will help NQTs to:

- Create a positive and safe environment for learning for all pupils
- Develop their tool-box of strategies to address a range of behaviour difficulties,
- Develop their confidence and presence in the classroom
- Develop and sustain positive relationships with pupils

### Module 2: Enabling outstanding learning for pupils

This module will help NQTs to:

- Broaden and expand their understanding of how quality teaching leads to outstanding learning.
- Develop their knowledge about how children learn and what can help or hinder this process.
- Activate research and self-reflection to develop their practice.
- Implement effective strategies for learning and building better learners e.g. growth mind set

### Module 3: Inclusive classrooms

This module will help NQTs to:

- Set appropriate challenge for all pupils including pupils with SEN and the more able.
- Teach using differentiation and the mastery approach in their lessons
- Create a language rich environment.
- Provide access to learning through the use of cross curricular links.

### Module 4: Enhancing learning through assessment

The module will help NQTs to:

- Clarify the purpose and rationale of assessment.
- Employ different types of assessment to inform next steps
- Reflect on how assessment procedures are led by school improvement priorities
- Identify good practice to support making consistent judgments around assessment.

### Module 5: Leading within the classroom

The module will help NQTs to:

- Lead effectively within the classroom.
- Optimise adult support to impact children's learning.
- Be equipped to deal with difficult conversations.
- Reflect on research in order to improve their practice.
